### **CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65 COMPLIANCE STATEMENT**

PEI-Genesis has evaluated its products for compliance with California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (commonly known as "Proposition 65"). For the reasons explained below, warning labels are not provided with PEI-Genesis products because they are exempt from and compliant with Proposition 65 without warning labels.

Proposition 65 requires warnings on products sold in California that contain Proposition 65-listed chemicals at levels that could cause significant exposure to consumers who purchase such products for their personal use or enjoyment. Products that contain Proposition 65-listed chemicals at levels that do not cause significant exposure to consumers are exempt from Proposition 65. Products that contain listed chemicals that are not manufactured for consumer use are also exempt from Proposition 65.

PEI-Genesis products are manufactured and marketed for industrial and commercial use. The Proposition 65 statute, regulations and federal case law provide that industrial and commercial products that contain Proposition 65-listed chemicals are exempt from the Proposition 65 consumer product warning requirement. Furthermore, products manufactured by out-of-state manufacturers, such as PEI-Genesis, and sold or used in California are subject only to the federal OSHA Hazard Communication Standard ("HCS") rules and exemptions for potential occupational exposure to Proposition 65-listed chemicals. PEI-Genesis products are also exempt from OSHA's HCS warning requirements because they meet the definition of "articles" that are not expected to cause occupational exposure.

Because PEI-Genesis products are exempt from Proposition 65, warning labels should not be placed on them, nor should warning labels be placed on the Internet when they are sold online.
